GUIDELINES FOR TEACHERS MODULE 1 - QUIZ

This activity is an **online quiz** with **12 multiple-choice questions**. You can play it in the classroom or with the whole school. There is no limit on the number of participants. It uses the online tool 'Kahoot'.

OBJECTIVES AND SKILLS

ATTITUDE

- The pupils are more aware of the EU. They want to know more about the European Union.
- The pupils are aware of the impact of the EU on their (daily) lives

KNOWI FDGF

- The pupils get to know some basic facts about the European Union.

STEP BY STEP

SETTING

Students can either play individually or in teams. This can be in a classroom setting, but also on the playground with many students at once. There is no limit to the number of participants in this online quiz.

As a teacher, you control the central panel with questions. All students are asked to use their smartphone, tablet or computer to play the quiz. They must first enter the quiz's game pin, and then their username. If done correctly, their name appears on the



screen in front.

Note: You can choose whether students play individually or in teams. Indicate on the control panel 'Classic' or 'Team mode'. You can choose the 'team mode' if not all students have a device.

PROCESS

The teacher waits until all students' names appear on the screen in front. The teacher then starts the quiz. The questions appear on the screen in front and the pupils use their device to answer. Students are awarded points according to the accuracy and speed of their answer. After every question, there is immediate feedback about the correct answer and how students answered (anonymous statistics). This way the teacher gets an overview of the basic knowledge of the pupils.

SOME TIPS

- If you have never used Kahoot before, it is recommended that you test the quiz beforehand. It is a very user-friendly tool. Once you have tested it, you will fully understand how it works.
- If you cannot play this quiz online because of logistical reasons, you can use the questions below to do the quiz in the 'old-fashioned' way.

CONTENT

There are 12 questions in the quiz. There are questions about basic facts, current issues and European values.
