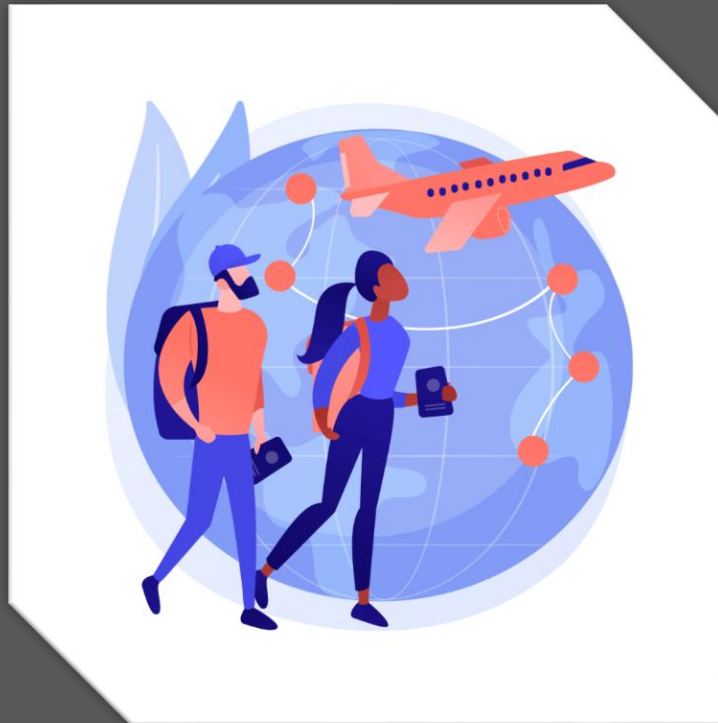
# Job Opportunities and Money
