 - Sports ⚽

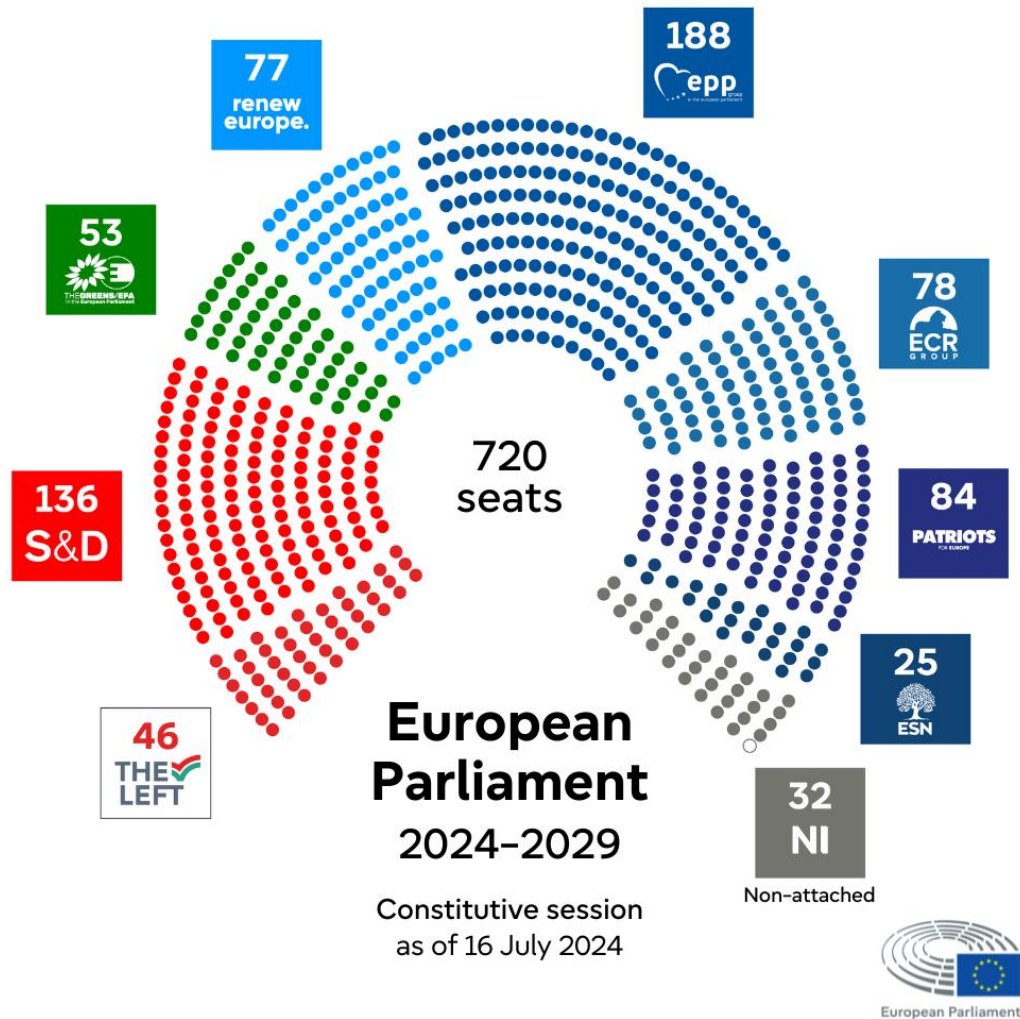


What does the European Parliament do?

- The EU didn't just happen. We all make it happen!

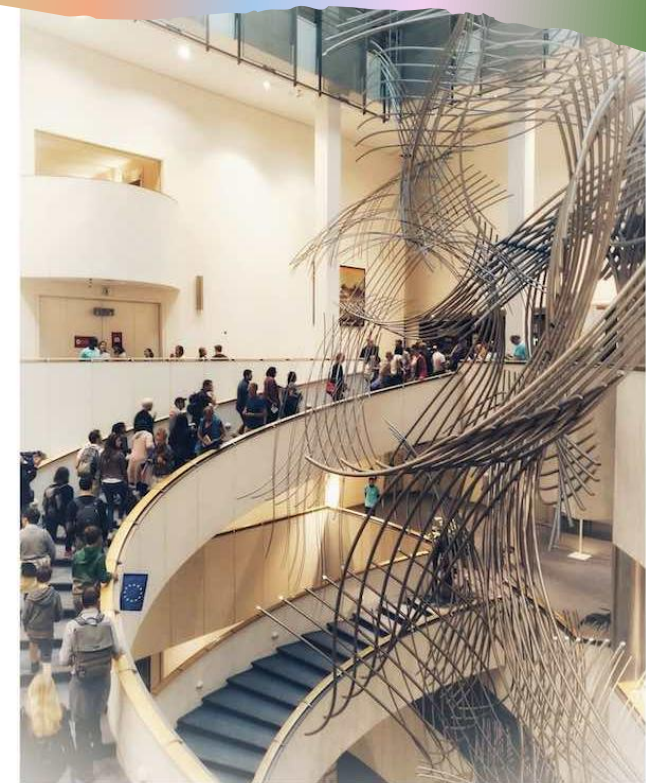
Europe Loves Sport and Music!
