FIRST MINISTER'S QUESTION TIME AT THE SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

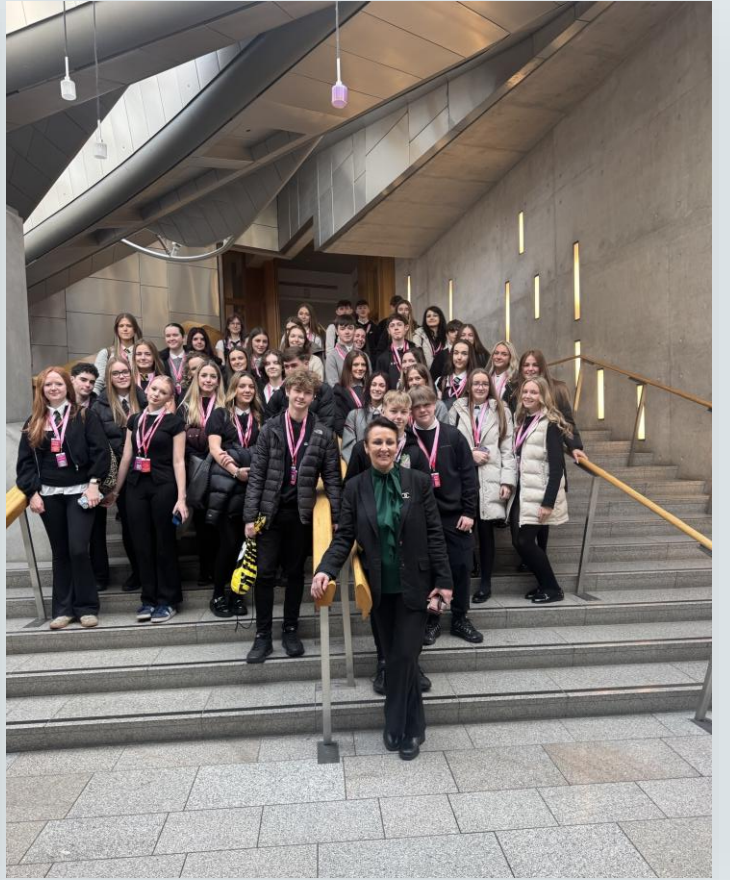


Our Senior Modern Studies and Politics pupils enjoyed watching First Minister's Question Time at the Scottish Parliament.
